i The Roper-Hall Eye Foundation is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This Cookie Policy together with our Privacy Policy (that can be found [here](#)), sets out the basis on which any personal information that we collect from you, or that you provide to us, when using this site will be processed.

This policy explains what cookies are and explains how, as well as why, they may be stored on and accessed from your computer or device when you use our website [www.roperhalleyfoundation.org] (the “**Website**”).

Information about our use of cookies

i Our site uses cookies (text files placed on your computer) which, if you agree, will collect standard internet log information and visitor behaviour information. This information is used to track visitor use of the site and to compile statistical reports on site activity.

By clicking ‘Accept’ on the Cookie Consent Banner when you first access our site and by continuing to access and use our site you accept our use of cookies. For your reference, we set out below the wording we use in our Cookie Consent Banner. m	Used by Stripe Payment Services for fraud prevention and detection	24 months
_stripe.mid	Stripe is used to make credit card payments. Stripe uses a cookie to remember who you are and to enable the website to process payments without storing any credit card information on its own servers	12 months

Cookie Name	Purpose	Duration
_ga	Used to identify unique users	24 months
_utma	Stores the number of visits made from the users' device, the time of the first visit, the previous visit, and the current visit.	
_utmb	Stores information on how long the user stays on a website which uses Google analytics: when a visit started and when ended. This cookie does not contain any personal information other than the IP address of your device	
_gat	Used to limit the number of requests	10 minutes
_gid	Used to track sessions, evaluate engagement and to view insights and overall traffic trends. It measures engagement time and engaged sessions	24 hours

Controlling and deleting cookies



There are two types of cookies:

- *Session cookies, that expire as soon as you close the browser and are mainly used to help you navigate the site by storing information on your location and the pages you have visited.*
- *Persistent or permanent cookies will remain on your computer once you close your browser down until expiry or deletion by you. These are mainly used to personalise the website, so that it remembers you from previous visits and can display relevant information.*


Using browser




You can set your browser not to accept cookies and information on how to remove cookies from your browser can be found here: <http://www.allaboutcookies.org/>. In a few cases, however, some of our site features may not work as a result. Also, note that disabling a cookie

or category of cookies does not delete the cookie from your browser unless manually completed through browser function.
